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Program Coordinator's Message Cindy Shepherd

Your Neighbors, Inc. which began as a vision and a dream some thirty years ago, continues to meet the needs of the frail, elderly and those persons with disabilities. In the six months that I have worked as the Program Coordinator for Your Neighbors, I have seen a tremendous increase in the number of clients being served. Clients are being referred from area hospitals, rehabilitation units, Visiting Nurse Association and Office for Aging. As documented in the Your Neighbors Emergency Food and Shelter grant, 3,519 meals were delivered from April 1, 2014 to March 31, 2015 compared to 1,126 meals delivered from April 9, 2013 through March 28, 2014.

I find it amazing that all the meals that are prepared and delivered and all of the transportation requests that are met and completed are done by volunteers. I have the highest praise for our current core of volunteers. They go above and beyond what is expected to meet the needs of those we serve and we are deeply appreciative. As the need in the community continues to increase, so does the need to recruit additional volunteers.

Your Neighbors, Inc. is in search of individuals who may have as little as two hours a month to help deliver meals or to transport someone to a doctor's appointment. Not only will you be helping someone in the community, you will meet some wonderful and amazing people.
